| <p>2 Feb 1882 Joyce born at 41 Brighton Square West, Rathgar (a Dublin suburb) 9</p> <p>1887 the family moves to Bray 7-59</p> <p>Sep 1888 Enrolls in Conglowes Wood College, a Jesuit school some 20 miles west of Dublin 9</p> <p>June 1891 Withdraws from Conglowes because his father had lost his job at Collector of Rates (taxes) for Dublin</p> <p>6 Oct 1891 Charles Stewart Parnell dies Joyce writes <i>Et Tu, Healy!</i> on the betrayal and death of Parnell 70</p> <p>1892 Family moves to Blackrock, about half way between Bray and Dublin 60ff.</p> <p>1893 Family moves to Dublin, their fortunes declining rapidly; 65 Joyce attends briefly the Christian Brothers' school in North Richmond Street</p> <p>Apr 1893 Enrolls in Belvedere College, a Jesuit school 71</p> <p>Feb 1894 Visits Cork to sell the last of the family property with his father 86-96</p> <p>Apr? 1894 Wins his first "exhibition" (a cash prize)</p> <p>1895 Joins the Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary</p> <p>1896 Elected prefect of the Sodality, the highest honor at Belvedere 104</p> <p>1897 Wins more prizes 96; re-elected prefect of the Sodality</p> <p>May 1898 Plays Grimstone in Anstey's <i>Vice Versâ</i>, taking off the rector of Belvedere 73-86</p> <p>Nov 1898 Retreat in honor of St. Francis Xavier 107-146</p> <p>1898 Graduates from Belvedere and enters University College, Dublin 165, 174ff</p> | <p>1899 Refuses to sign the student protest against Yeats's <i>The Countess Cathleen</i> 226</p> <p>1904 stories</p> <p>10 Jun 1904 meets Nora Barnacle</p> <p>1905 Moves to Trieste, Giorgio (son) born</p> <p>1906 Moves to Rome</p> <p>1907 Moves to Trieste; Lucia (daughter) born</p> <p>1908 Finishes three chapters of <i>Portrait</i></p> <p>1909 Visits Ireland</p> <p>1910 Returns to Trieste</p> <p>1911 Throws <i>Portrait</i> into the fire; his sister Eileen rescues it and lays it by</p> <p>1912 Makes his last trip to Ireland</p> <p>1914 <i>Portrait</i> published as a serial in <i>The Egoist</i> (London) from 2 Feb to Sep 1915</p> <p>1915 Moves to Zurich</p> <p>1916 <i>Portrait</i> published in New York</p> <p>1918 <i>Ulysses</i> serialized in New York, March 1918-December 1920</p> <p>1919 Returns to Trieste</p> <p>1920 Moves to Paris; <i>Ulysses</i> publication blocked as pornography</p> <p>1922 Sylvia Beach publishes <i>Ulysses</i> in Paris at Shakespeare & Co.</p> <p>1923 Begins <i>Finnegans Wake</i></p> <p>1931 Moves to London</p> <p>4 Jul 1931 Marries Nora</p> <p>29 Dec 1931 Joyce's father dies</p> <p>15 Feb 1932 Stephen James Joyce (grandson by Giorgio) born</p> <p>1933 <i>Ulysses</i> declared not pornographic in the U.S.</p> <p>1934 <i>Ulysses</i> published in New York by Random House</p> <p>1936 <i>Collected Poems</i> published</p> <p>1939 <i>Finnegans Wake</i> published; Moves to France</p> <p>1940 Moves to Zurich</p> <p>13 Jan 1941 Joyce dies in Zurich</p> |
